

PacificNet Wireless Access

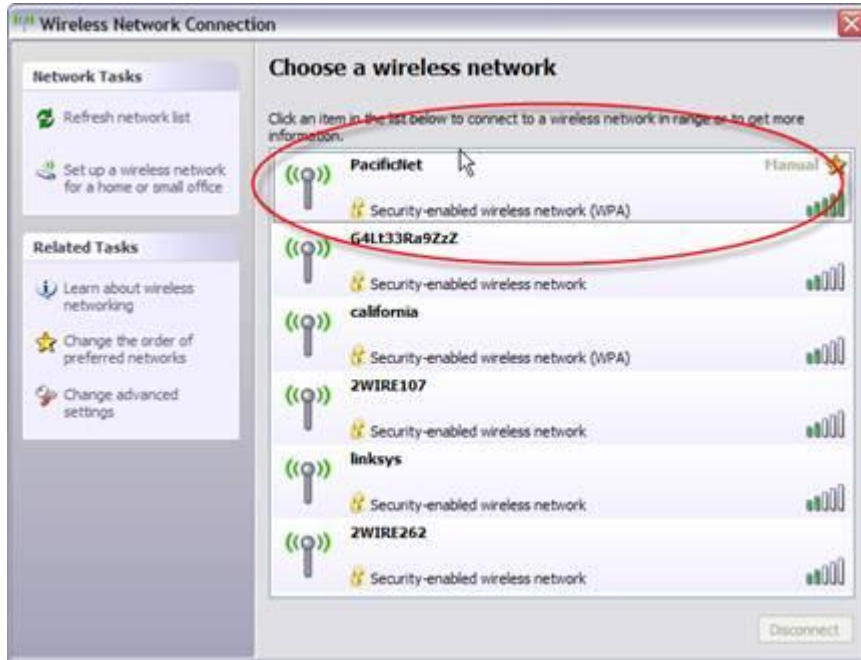
For DDS and IDS students, the Dell Latitude laptops you have been issued should be preconfigured to access the **PacificNet** wireless network. PacificNet is only guaranteed to be accessible from the following locations:

- Rooms 103, 104
- Cafe Cagnone on 2nd floor
- Classrooms 304 and 308
- Room 411
- Classrooms 511A, 511B, 515A, and 515B

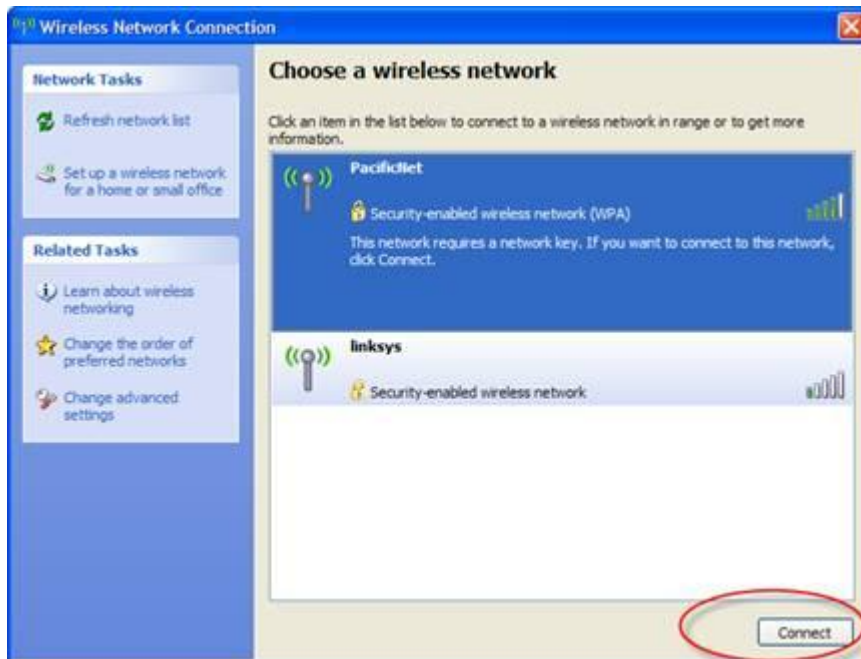
Assuming that your laptop has been [configured](#) to access PacificNet, you may see a bubble prompting you to “Click here to select a certificate or other credentials for connection to the network PacificNet”. Click the bubble as directed. Alternatively, you can right-click on the wireless network icon and then click “View Available Wireless Networks” (see below).



This will bring up the following window:



To connect to PacificNet wireless, click within the PacificNet box, then click on the Connect button located on the bottom-right corner of the window.

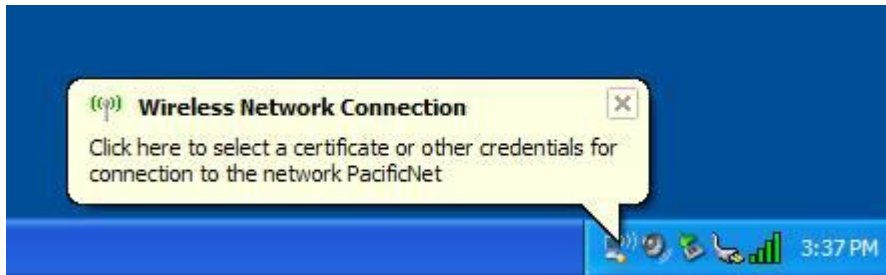


A Wireless Network Connection window may pop up in front of that window (shown below), while it is searching for a wireless signal.



Please be patient while it goes through a process of authenticating, validating, and connecting to the wireless network.

You will see another bubble window, prompting you to click within the window to "...select a certificate or other credentials for..." (like the first prompt).

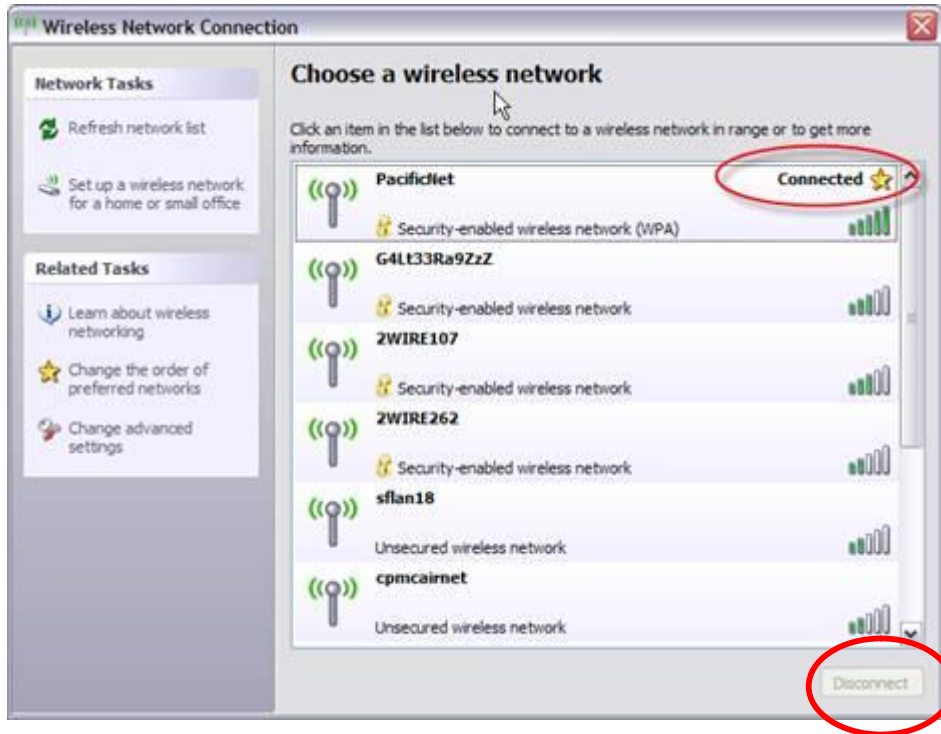


You will see the Enter Credentials window as shown below.



Complete the window with your network **account** and **password**. Be sure to use SF as the domain.

You will see the following when you are connected wirelessly to the network.



Security note

When you are done using the wireless network, we recommend you log off your computer and/or disconnect from PacificNet wireless. To disconnect from Pacific Net, click within the PacificNet box to select it, then click the disconnect button on the lower right corner of the window.
