Title: “Wake Up Your Practice to Dental Sleep Medicine”

Course Description:

With the increasing awareness of airway and sleep, dentistry is a vital component to identifying possible underlying systemic conditions. There is a rise in sleep apnea, TMD and airway issues in both adults and children. It all begins with taking a closer look at sleep, oral conditions and medical history. Consequently, the dental community plays an important role in helping uncover root causes and screening for airway health.

- 1) Learn how to screen both adults and children for potential airway conditions.
- 2) Learn how to motivate your team to implement dental sleep medicine.
- 3) Understand how collaboration with the medical community plays an important role in dental sleep medicine.

Title: "Paying Attention to Pediatric Airway in the Dental Setting"

Course Description:

Pediatric Airway is a growing concern in our world today. The rise in sleep apnea paired with the number of adenoid and tonsillectomy surgery in the US is growing. What can we do in the dental community to curb that trajectory and how can you help someone who is unaware of the possibility of a sleep disorder in your dental chair?

Objectives:

- 1) Learn to build awareness among your patients and dental team to screen for pediatric airway.
- 2) Integrate a system during an exam or hygiene recare check.
- 3) Implement a protocol that screens children within the scope of dentistry.
