Subject Area: Tales from the pediatric dental office: Practical Pearls for the GD

Title: “Pediatric Dentistry Case Studies - The Fun Side of the Daily Grind”

Course Description:

This course will allow dentists and their teams to remember why it's fun to see pediatric patients. We will review unusual findings in case study format. Attendees will be given tips and tricks from a board-certified pediatric dentist to help make seeing pediatric patients in a general dental setting rewarding and worthwhile.

Objectives:

- 1) To remind dentists and their teams of the proper protocol for seeing pediatric patients safely.
- 2) To remind dentists of unusual pathology most commonly seen in infants, kids and teens.
- 3) To allow dental team members a greater role in the pediatric visit.
- 4) To encourage dental teams to work together to see kids in a general seeing.
- 5) To review common trauma protocol with dental teams.
