Student Research Request Procedures for Study of the S. R. Atkinson Library of Applied Anatomy

Research study of the Spencer R. Atkinson Library of Applied Anatomy (Atkinson Collection) must take place at the dental school in the Center's designated research area (Room 410).

The University of the Pacific student requesting access to the collection should provide the following in a one-page proposal:

- Name, graduating class year, program, phone number and email address
- Name and department of faculty sponsor supporting your research project
- Provide statement agreeing to send pdfs of abstracts, publications, posters, MSDs and full citations of any work resulting from this study
- Explain purpose for examination of the collection, including:
 - General hypothesis and methodology; description of procedure
 - What type of specimens you expect to examine (i.e., age groups, ethnic groups, particular syndromes, pathologies, etc.)
- Explain methods of examination of the collection, including:
 - Describe in detail what anatomical structures you plan to examine or measure (i.e., parts of the dentition, particular parts of the skull, specific anatomical features, etc.)
 - Describe in detail what equipment you expect to use during the study (i.e., calipers [describe previous use experience], camera, X-ray, MicroScribe digitizer, scanner, etc.)
- Indicate whether you expect participation by other students or faculty in the taking of measurements, photos, X-rays, scans, etc., and the name and affiliation of other researcher(s) and what their tasks will be
- Provide *suggested* date(s) and proposed duration of your study
