

- Multiple osteomas (Gardner)


Florid Osseous Dysplasia






Osteitis Deformans

- Elderly
- Polyostotic
- Skull and Jaws (Cotton Wool)
 - Maxilla>Mandible
- Cranial Nerve Deficits
- Mosaic Bone
- Alkaline Phosphatase
- Normal Calcium, Phosphorus
- Giant Cell Lesions, Sarcomas









- Single Quadrant
- Infectious Source
 - Anaerobic bacteria
 - Odontogenic ?
- Expansile, Ill-defined
- Culture and Sensitivity
- Long Course Antibiotics



Exostoses and Tori

Mandibular Tori








The Gardner Syndrome
