"Overdentures - The Gateway to Full Arch"

Course Description:

In the world of terminal dentition we are quick to talk about full fixed immediate load options that end in high end zirconia bridges. Today with the climbing prices of full fixed we need to pursue more affordable options for these patients. Overdentures can provide your patients a life changing long term solution as well as the opportunity for them to upgrade later on.

Objectives:

- 1) How to Diagnose and Treatment plan the full arch solution.
- 2) Understanding the amount of restorable space needed for the appropriate final restoration.
- 3) Dental materials available for the temporary and final restorations.

Dr. Moody was the 5th generation to grow up on the Moody Cattle Ranch in Western Nebraska, attended the University of Nebraska Lincoln, later graduating from the University of Oklahoma College of Dentistry in 1997.
